Venue Team Roles

Venue Chair

The Venue Chair runs the monthly venue team meetings. They will be given a venue development plan that will guide their meeting agendas. Venue Chairs ensure effective integrated planning and coordination that happens between venue team representatives from the various function areas for their designated venue. They will work very closely with the Sport Chair who is responsible for the field of play operations. The Venue Chair will also have a particular focus on the site layout including the placement and installation of any temporary structures such as fencing, bleachers, tents, signs, etc. During Games time, the Venue Chair oversees the operation of the venue.

Event Services

Event Services are responsible for ensuring a safe and secure environment for all. Volunteers will assist in the areas of ticket taking, greeting, information services, access control and ushering of spectators, including accessibility and environmental services. Teamwork, good communication skills and a customer service attitude will be essential in making this area run well.

Technology

Technology services is the backbone that makes all Games operational. This area is responsible for the commissioning and decommissioning of the technology equipment at all competition and non-competition venues, including the distribution, setup/takedown of hardware and providing on-site support during and post-Games time. Prior experience with information technology and troubleshooting issues is an asset.

Transportation

Essential in keeping the Games running, transportation is responsible for planning and coordinating a flexible and efficient transportation service for all Games participants. There will be three main areas of responsibility: airport arrivals and departures, the bussing system and fleet vehicles to ensure that all arrive safely and on time to venues. Roles in this function area can include drivers, dispatch and parking control.



Food Services

Food Services volunteers will assist in various activities relating to the feeding of Games athletes, volunteers and officials at competition and non-competition venues. Serving and presenting refreshment and food options, as well as ensuring eating areas are kept clean, may be required. This area will have high traffic and high volume peak times that will require teamwork to meet expectations.

Volunteer Services

Volunteers in this area will work in numerous capacities designed to support the volunteer workforce through the various phases of the Games, such as recruitment, screening and training of volunteers to ensure they are ready for Games time deployment. At the Volunteer Centre, volunteers will be providing administrative and communications support, assisting and supporting in the coordination of screening, training and orientation, scheduling and uniforming of volunteers.

At Games time, Volunteer Services will oversee the Volunteer experience. Stationed in the venue Volunteer Lounges, volunteers in this area will serve as the main point of contact for check-in/check-out, resolve accreditation issues, as well as maintaining volunteer food service areas. Volunteers deployed in this role need to be customer-service oriented and enjoy working with all individuals.
