## You can schedule yourself with “Smart Sign-Up”

The Smart Sign-Up shifts that are visible in your profile will match your selected interests.

For ease of training and accreditation, limit yourself to one or two roles.

Help with Smart Sign-Up is available at the UDAC.

### Smart Sign-up Instructions:

To use Smart Sign-up to choose your own tasks, location and shifts, log in to your profile in GEMS.pro (<https://wcsq2019.gems.pro/Volunteer/List.aspx>) using your USER ID # and your password. You can also find the log-in link on our website under Volunteer ([www.2019wcsq.ca/volunteer](http://www.2019wcsq.ca/volunteer)). Then, follow the instructions below:

1. Once logged in, click "Welcome".
2. Under the "My Registration Profile", click 'Smart Sign-up'. (A "Workforce Self-Scheduling" instructional video may pop-up. If the video does not appear, click the '?' to view.)
3. Under "Sub Area", select the sub area that appeals to you. The sub areas that are listed here match those that you have selected under Interests. If you wish to update these interests, you can do so by clicking "Registration" in the left-hand menu and selecting additional "Interests" and click "Save".
4. Once you have chosen a Sub Area, click on "Tasks" to see the types of jobs that are available to be done. Select a task that interests you.
5. You can then select a "Location" where you would like to perform this task.
6. The available dates and shift times will appear under "Date".
7. Choose the shifts that work for your schedule and click "OK" to schedule yourself for those shifts.
